

VLP1 – first seven months

 Over 8000 registrations - 68% have achieved pass certificates

Over 400 organisations registered – wide range

National Volunteer Framework produced

IMO Project

- 30 delegates from BME community
- 4 tutorials 'preparing for Volunteering' including Volunteer Learning Passport modules.
- More than 50% required 1:1 support with IT
- 33% needed help with language and IT.

IMO project outcomes

- 28 people completed all the modules
- Over 50% in voluntary roles or work within a few weeks
- A second cohort is now underway

Other volunteer project outcomes:

- Six Pennine Lancashire Volunteer Manager learning events
- High profile presence during Volunteers Week and project presentations
- 'Volunteers into Health & Social Care' scheme in progress
