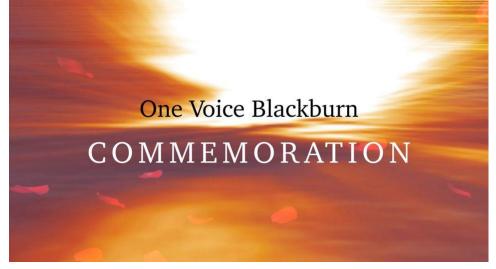

Amazing Women – more correctly Discover Amazing Women by Rail is a project that was launched on 27th March 2018 and invites people to leave the car at home and use the train (along with buses and trams) to explore the fascinating, and often hidden, histories of women who lived and worked along the Mid Cheshire and Calder Valley railway lines and also including the route from Blackburn to Manchester via Todmorden.

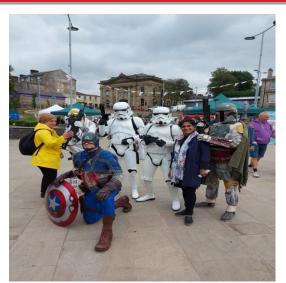


A big thank you to Public Services who attended Darwen Rotary Family-Day and took part in the activities.
