Description of the Opportunity

We couldn't keep the Charge my Street service running 24/7 without the help of our volunteers. Phoneline volunteers will be there for EV drivers' when they feel they have no one else to turn to. Charge my Street volunteer you'll be there for EV drivers' when they feel they have no one else to turn to, by giving a regular shift of up to 4 hours each week working remotely to help get charging sessions started, answer payment queries and unlock cables that are trapped in chargepoints. Our trained phone advisors support people who are using our chargepoints, getting in touch via phone, or email.

Essential Skills/ Qualities Required

While we think our Charge my Street roles are suitable for a whole range of people, we are particularly looking for those with the following qualities and experience:

- passionate about helping EV drivers
- great communication skills
- empathetic and perceptive
- able to think on your feet
- works well within a team
- emotional resilience.

Signing up to be a Charge my Street volunteer is a big commitment and requires training so we do ask people to stay in the role for a minimum of one year.
